Have you heard the news? ISU Credit Union announced that the popular REWARDS Plus Checking, would pay higher interest on higher balances!

\*Annual Percentage Yield (APY) accurate as of June 1, 2016. Reward Rate qualifications per cycle: • 12 debit card transactions must post and clear • Must receive electronic statements • Must have at least 1 direct deposit or automatic payment. Rate tiers are as follows: 2.5% APY applies to balances of \$.01 - \$20,000 and 0.25% APY applies to the portion of balances over \$20,000 as long as qualifications are met each statement cycle. 0.01% APY applies to all balances if qualifications are not met. Rates may change after the account is opened. Fees may reduce earnings. No minimum balance required. Available to personal accounts only. ATM fee refunds up to \$25 per cycle when qualifications are met.
